Solar Sector Shifts Gear From Expansion to Excellence

The solar energy landscape is entering a transformative phase — not just growing, but maturing. Over the past two months, both global and Indian solar markets have witnessed key shifts that redefine how manufacturers, developers, and policy-makers approach renewable energy.

Globally, the solar sector continues its upward momentum, with over 380 GW of new capacity added in the first half of 2025 — a remarkable 64% year-on-year growth. Despite cost pressures, solar remains the most affordable energy source worldwide, with the levelised cost of electricity (LCOE) dropping to as low as US \$27 per MWh in some regions. The focus is now shifting from capacity expansion to quality, reliability, and system integration.

In India, the industry is moving from rapid expansion to strategic consolidation. The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) has declared a “consolidation phase”, prioritising grid integration, hybrid storage systems, and compliance with the Authorised List of Models and Manufacturers (ALMM) effective from September 2025. Rooftop installations have surged — up 158% in the first half of the year — highlighting India’s growing adoption of decentralised solar solutions.

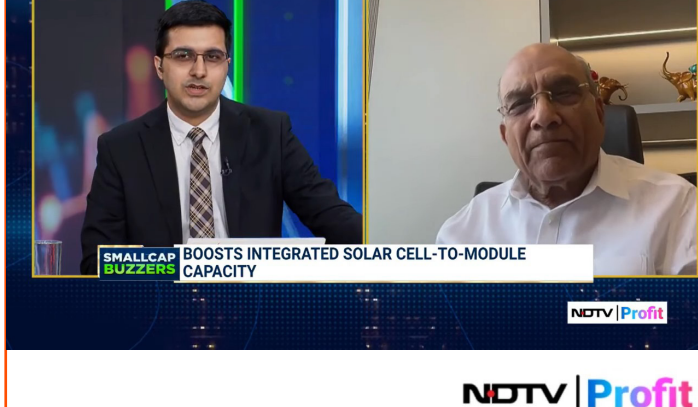

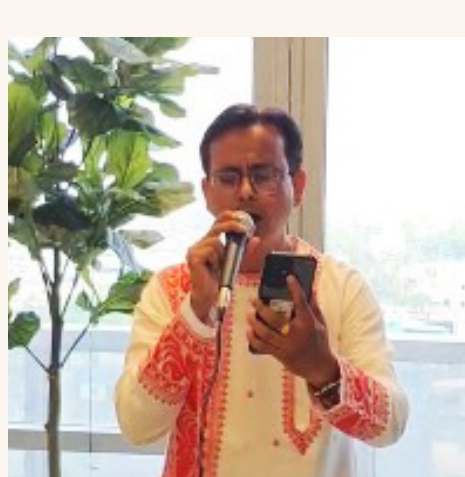

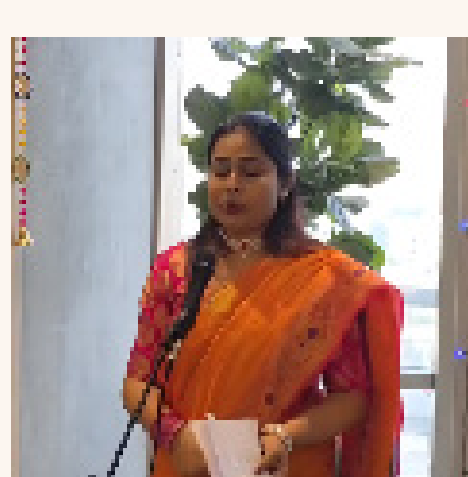
